This summer we will be attending the Rocky Mountain Slate Team Camp in Gunnison, CO on June 14-17. If you are planning on wrestling varsity next year, or if you'd just like to improve as a wrestler, this is the camp for you. The camp is primarily focused on competition, with limited time for work on technique. Anyone going to the camp should plan on attending our summer workouts to prepare for the camp.

We will be departing for the camp on Wednesday, June 13 at noon and will spend the night at a hotel/motel in Colorado. Sunday morning we will take a break at the Great Sand Dunes before heading to Gunnison for the camp. After the camp concludes on Sunday we will drive home, arriving back in Hutchinson around 10:00 PM.

The camp fee is \$255 (\$275 if registered late); make your check payable to "WSCU." A nonrefundable deposit of \$100 is due with the registration, with the balance due upon arrival at camp. There will not be any charge for transportation or overnight lodging (our fundraising will be used to cover these fees), but there will be a fee for the whitewater rafting (I estimate about \$45).

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT TO HOLD HARMLESS AND EMERGENCY RELEASE FORM

As the parent/legal guardian of the camper (coach*) named here _____ (participant); it is understood that playing or participating in any sport can be a dangerous activity involving MANY RISKS OF INJURY. It is understood that the dangers and risks of playing or practicing to play/participate in wrestling include, but are not limited to, death, serious neck injury or impairment to other aspects of the body, general health and well being. It is understood that the dangers and risks involved with playing or participating in wrestling may result not only in serious injury, but in a serious impairment of one's future abilities to earn a living, to engage in other business, social and recreational activities, and generally to enjoy life.

The following additional activities are engaged in at the Rocky Mountain Wrestling Camps (RMWC). Each participant may be involved in any one of these activities. Each of these activities also has certain inherent risks similar to those mentioned above. These activities include but are not limited to: running, hiking, fishing, transportation by vehicle, swimming, basketball, weight lifting, racquetball, softball, frisbee, touch type football, volleyball, and more. White water rafting trips are available to those groups wishing to pursue them from local guides. This is NOT organized or sanctioned by the RMWC.

By signing below, the participant and parent/legal guardian hereby assume all risks associated with participation and agree to hold Western State Colorado University, The Rocky Mountain Wrestling Camps (RMWC), RMWC Director and all agents, coaches and volunteers harmless from any and all liability, actions, causes of action, debts, claims, or demands of any kind and heirs, estate, executor, administrator, assignees, and for all members of the family.

Additionally, by signing below the participant and parents/legal guardians understand, in the event of an emergency every effort will be made to contact them. However, in the event they cannot be reached, this form hereby gives permission to the physician selected by the RMWC to hospitalize and secure proper treatment (including surgery) for the participant.

Moreover, by the parent AND participant signing this form, they are agreeing to abide by all camp rules and reasonable authority of the camp staff and that the participant has been deemed physically able to participate in wrestling and recreational activities by a physician. ***Coaches are signing as their own self guardian.**
